

EWB Denmark: List of References

Pakistan (2011): Preparation of community based disaster risk reduction project

Liberia (2011): Assistance by two engineers to UNHCR/DRC in providing transport infrastructure (roads and bridges) for the refugees coming from Ivory Coast into Liberia.

Tanzania (2010): Muavika water and sanitation project in cooperation with ASF

Sierra Leone (2011): Rainwater harvesting and improved sanitation incl WASH programme for village population of war amputees

Tanzania (2010): Village water supply, Teraja Village.

Haiti (2010): Assistance after the earth quake to shelter building by 4 EWB Denmark members. Shelters were 14 m² in plywood built on the foundations of the destroyed house.

Sierra Leone (2009): Study of improvement to power, water supply and sanitary facilities on Massanga hospital.

Sierra Leone (2009-10): Construction of a village school in cooperation with Engineers without Borders, Sierra Leone. After 10 years of civil war in which many villagers had hands or feet cut off Sierra Leone has a large number of people without any possibility for working and providing school for their children. The new school is for 150 children aged 3 to 8 and 60 adults for evening classes in the Kenema district.

Liberia (2009-10): Assistance by two members to UNHCR/DRC for reconstruction of bridges destroyed during the civil war.

Palestine (2009-10): Students' project comprising solar power in poor villages on the West Bank of Palestine in cooperation with EWB-Israel and EWB-Palestine.

Togo (2009-10): Village water supply to Kovie in cooperation with PRODECK *Programme pour le developpement et l'education dans le canton de Kovie* comprising well and water tower.

Uganda (2009): 6 months assignment through DRC assisting in establishing markets for smallholders and thereby improving prices and living conditions..

Myanmar (2008): Fact-finding mission for ASF-Dansk Folkehjælp, preparing for housing and water supply for refugees.

Uganda (2008): Three months supervision of installations on a combined church and school project for 200 orphans.

Lebanon (2007): Providing Project Manager for housing reconstruction following the war between Israel and Hizbollah

Togo (2007): Survey for a health clinic in Kovie.

Lesotho (2007): Students' project in Lesotho evaluating a solar hat collection system in a DANIDA financed hospital.

Chad (2007): Establishing water supply and sanitation in three refugee camps with a total of 45,000 people for Danish Church Aid and Kirkens Nødhjelp, Norway.

Mozambique (2007): Assistance to Danish Red Cross establishing a camp incl. water and sanitation for aid workers following large flooding.

The Sudan (2006): Providing camp planner to Danish Refugee Council to establish way-stations in Southern Sudan incl. offices, water and sanitation for UNHCR staff.

The Sudan (2006): Assistance to Danish Church Aid in de-mining in Nuba Mountains.

Lebanon (2006): Assistance to Danish Refugee Council in establishing aid stores after the war between Israel and Hizbollah.

Angola (2006): Development of de-mining programme for danish Church Aid.

Pakistan (2005): Establishing complete camp for 50 Red Cross International aid workers after the earth quake.

The Sudan (2005): Technical assistance to UNHCR for erecting camps in Southern Sudan.

Ossetia (2005): Technical assistance to UNHCR, erection of staff quarters.

Indonesia (2005): Tsunami emergency assistance. Camp management for 6 months for Red Cross in Meulaboh and transport coordination.

Indonesia (2005): Tsunami emergency assistance. Erection of camp and office facilities for 60 Red Cross aid workers incl. all electrical, water supply and sanitary facilities.

Tchad (2004-05): Camp planning and water supply for refugee camps for some 50,000 refugees from Darfur, Southern Sudan.

Bulgaria (2005 og 2006/08) : Renovation of a hospital for handicapped adults and children.
