We do not accept politically based contributions.

All members and staff are accountable and under an obligation to raise any issue of doubts with the IuG Board for clarification.

We strive as individuals and as organisation to adhere to international standards and norms for international humanitarian engagement as outlined in the Core Humanitarian Standards.
