

Assessment prior to deployment of safe and healthy working and living conditions Indicators to be applied

/may be included in pre deployment checklist and/or Handbook for handling EU Aid Volunteers. You may decide ranking method appropriate for the purpose, which should be both measurable and relevant.

Mapping / information of diseases prevalent in the area (water-, mosquito-, human-borne, seasonal, etc.), including the level of likelihood and impacts;	
Availability and accessibility of first-aid support (internally and externally), fire wardens and services, medical facilities and professionals (e.g. hospitals, nurses, access to medication) to be assured;	
The level of maintenance for all locations (offices and accommodation); availability of electricity points, lighting, ventilation, sanitation and hygiene facilities to be assured;	
The level of vehicle maintenance, regular inspection and servicing, appropriate equipment (such as radio, first-aid kit, seat belts, water, blanket) e) availability and quality of desk space, chairs, computer equipment;	
Provisions for leave and working hours; access to recreational activities and sports facilities, libraries, markets, etc.; degree of remoteness; access to private space, religious buildings; to be informed on and
